

How to View Clips in the Clip Library:

Getting to the Video Analysis of Teaching Homepage:

Copy and paste the following link into your web browser.

<http://www.hunter.cuny.edu/school-of-education/technology/vat/overview>

You can also access this link by going to www.hunter.cuny.edu/education. Then click on “Current Students.” This will open a new list of links, in the navigation panel on the left. Click on “Video Analysis of Teaching”.
